Still, you may want to roll his outlook back a few points. Danny Cleary also stands to lose some PP time.

Bertuzzi probably won't play 70 games in a season again in his career. That puts his upside in the mid to high 50s now, which he could hit in Detroit. It's an ideal situation for him.
