## **PRO DIVISION**

It's time to take a look at what happened in the very competitive middle tier of Dobber's three-tiered pool, the Pro Division. This one was a tight affair until February and then it was a two horse race to the finish. As of Halloween, ten of the top 12 teams were separated by only 15 points. By the end of November, eight of the 12 teams were within 9.5 points of first place.
