

Since his 101 point 2009-10 season, Nicklas has seen his points per game total go on a wild rollercoaster ride from 1.23 PPG, to a massive drop off at .84 PPG in 2010-11, followed by a nice bounce back last season at 1.05 PPG. This leads us to today's career low .73 PPG rate of play, well below the 25-year-old's high-end capabilities. Let's take a quick look at Frozen Pool's Most Frequent line combinations output generator, to see if any hypotheses can be derived... Beginning with the apex of this Capitals era, the 2009-10 regular season until today, these are Backstrom's most paired up linemates. 


